BACKGROUND

The free summer school program is extending an invitation to all government school students residing within Sangana and its environs. This initiative is designed to address the educational challenges faced by many children in the area, primarily due to economic hardships. As a result, most children can only attend school for 1 to 3 days out of the 5-day school week, as they are often required to stay home to help with household chores or other responsibilities. This irregular attendance frequently leads to academic struggles and semester failures.

MISSION

The mission of our summer school program is to bridge this gap by revisiting and reinforcing what the children have learned during the previous school year. Additionally, we aim to incorporate engaging activities and discussions through our summer school programme, fostering a supportive and enriching learning environment to help these students succeed.

VISION

By 2030, we envision the expansion of our Free Summer School Program across multiple states in Nigeria, creating equal opportunities for early learners nationwide through inclusive, quality education and holistic child development.



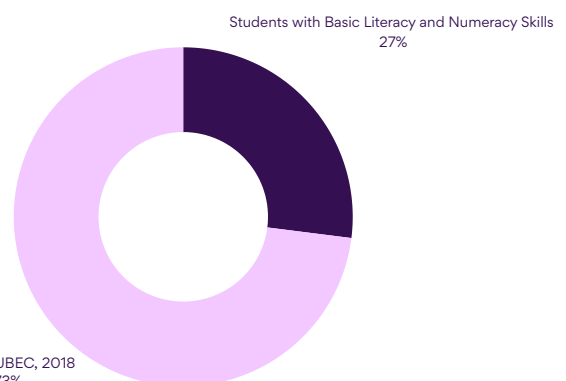
PROBLEM STATEMENT

Education in Nigeria, particularly in rural areas like the Sangana community in Rivers State, faces significant challenges. Access to quality education is unevenly distributed, with many children lacking the resources and opportunities to develop essential academic, creative, and life skills. The existing day school system provides a basic foundation, but it often falls short in offering a well-rounded education that combines theoretical knowledge with practical applications. This gap limits children's ability to think critically, express themselves creatively, and acquire skills that are crucial for their future success.

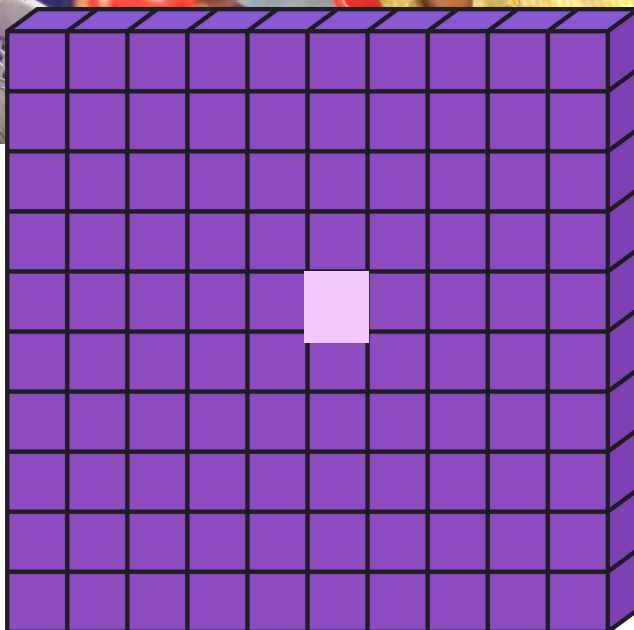

Moreover, the increasing rate of poverty in the Sangana community has forced many parents to prioritize economic survival over their children's education. Parents often have to sell goods in the market or engage in other income-generating activities, leaving them unable to ensure their children's regular school attendance. As a result, many children only attend school once or twice a week, severely disrupting their learning process and academic progress. This irregular attendance further widens the educational gap, as children miss out on critical lessons and fall behind their peers.



100:1

is the learner-to-classroom ratio in many Nigerian Schools, which exceeds the recommended ratio of 30:1 to 40:1, especially at the basic education level.

Many Nigerian Public Schools face severe overcrowding, with learner-to classroom ratios reaching up to 100:1 in some states, hindering effective teaching and learning. Overcrowded classrooms lead to poor academic performance and educator burnout. By offering academic reinforcement during breaks, summer school can spread out the learning load and reduced term-time pressure on overburdened classrooms.

Okachi Charity Foundation's Free Summer School Program aims to address these issues by providing a transformative educational experience that bridges the gap between theory and practice. By offering a comprehensive curriculum that includes academic enrichment, creative exploration, and skill development, the program seeks to inspire academic growth, foster creativity, and equip children with the tools they need to succeed in life. The program also aims to provide a structured and supportive environment where children can attend regularly, even if their parents are occupied with work, ensuring that they do not miss out on valuable learning opportunities.

Technology & Innovation

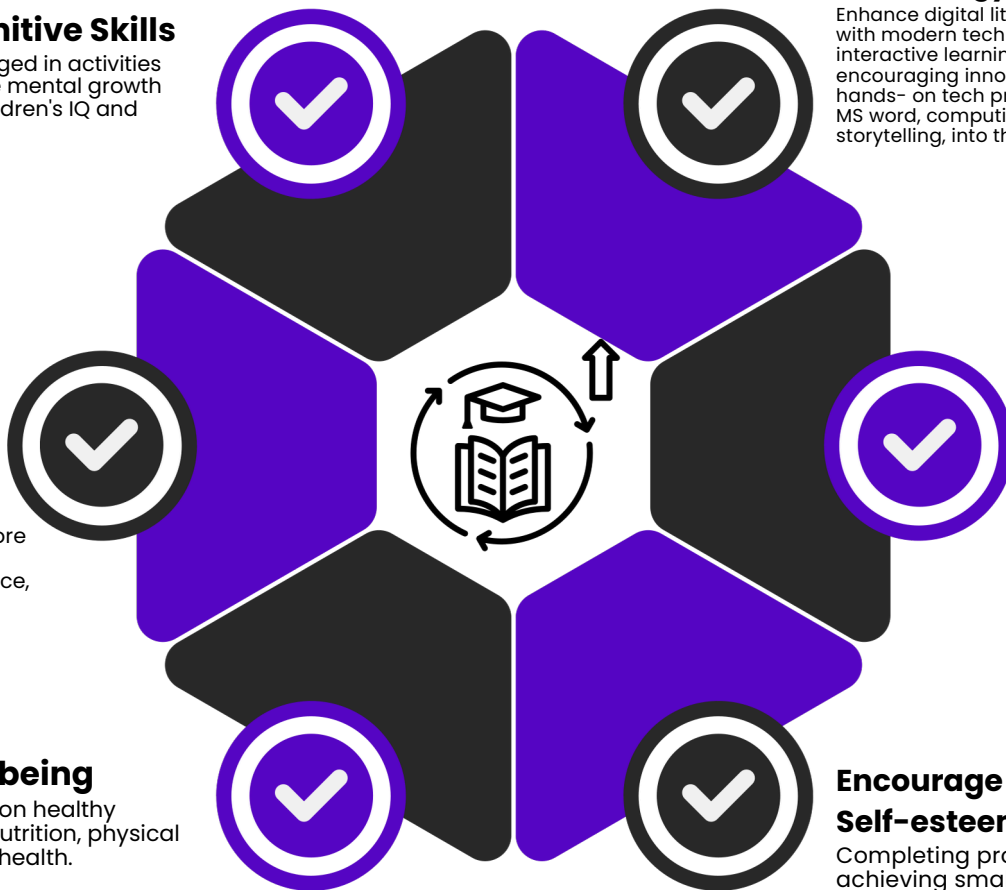

TEAM ACTIVITIES

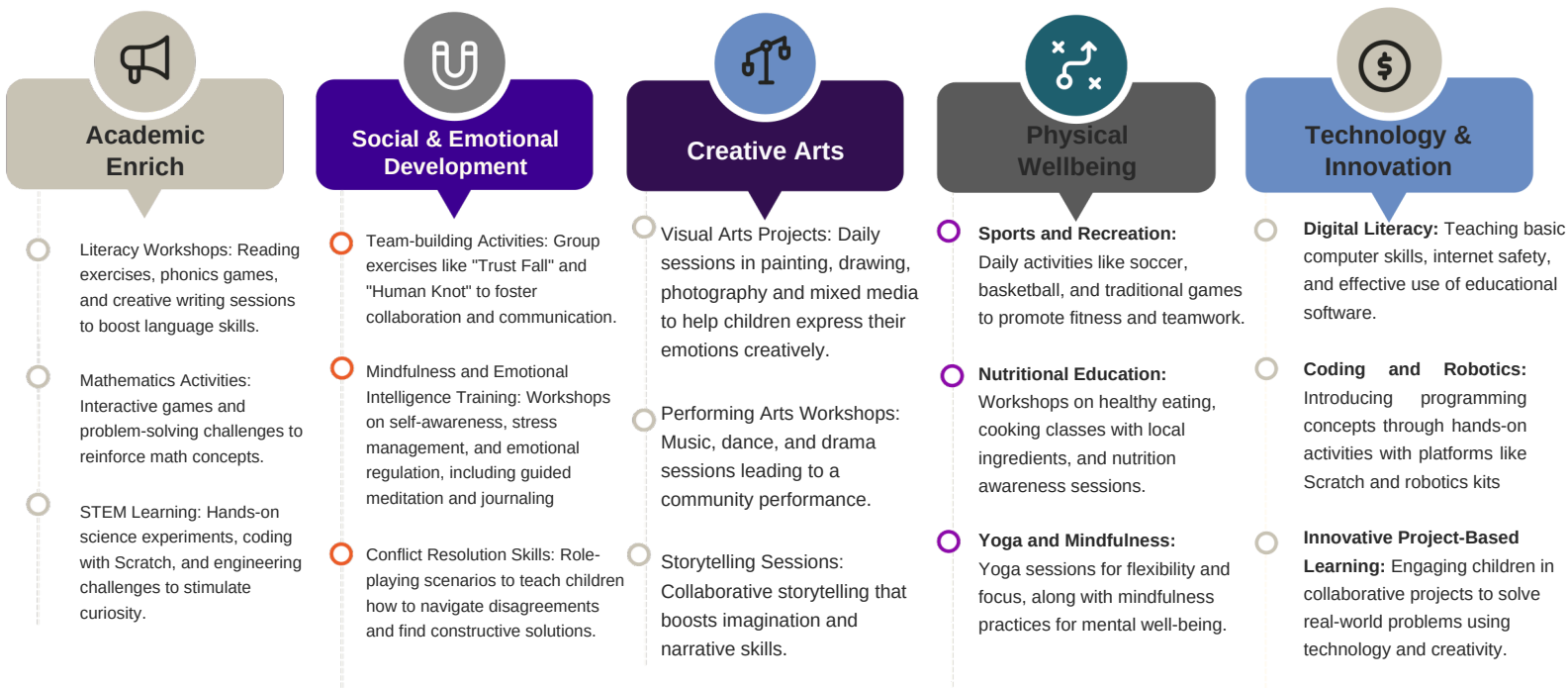
- Group projects to encourage collaboration and social skills (Debate, Spelling Bee e.t.).

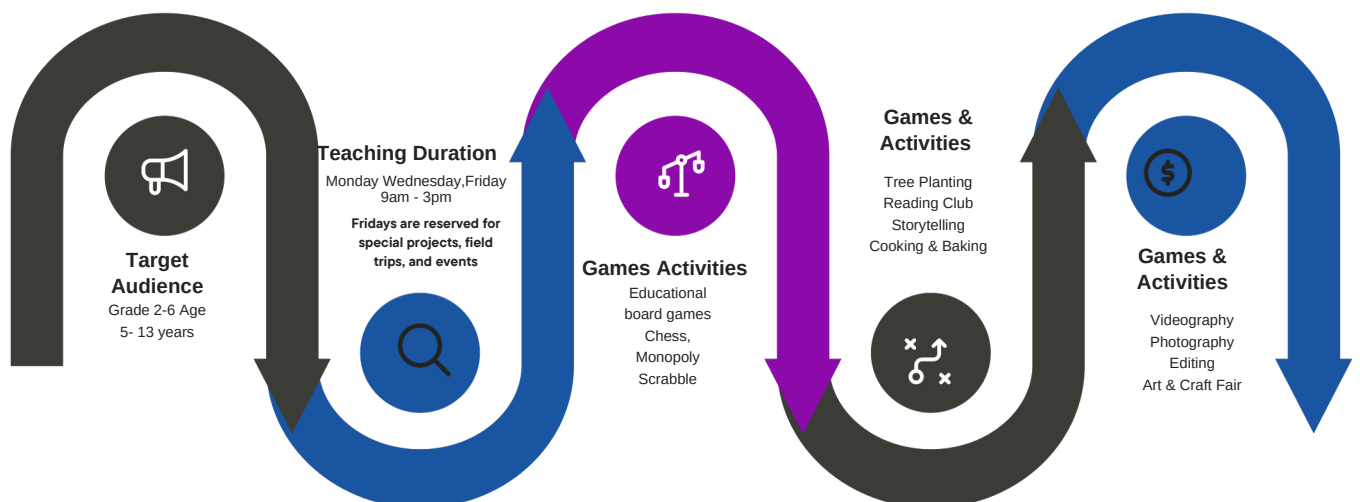

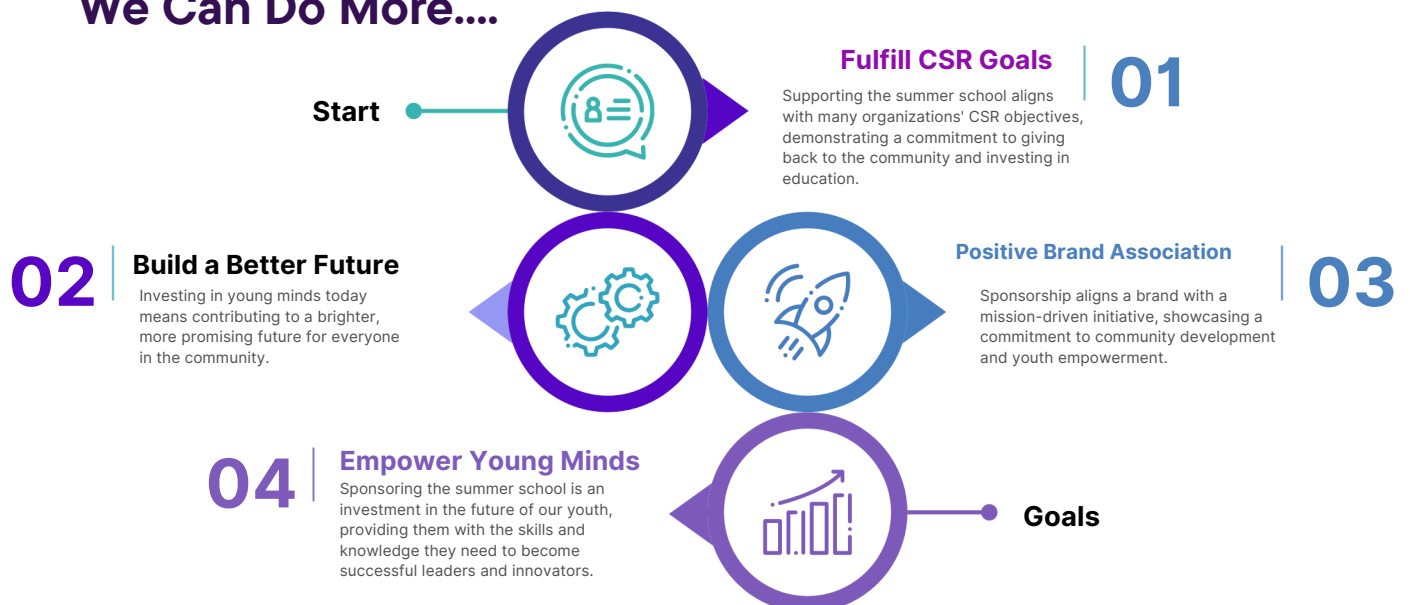
WHY YOU SHOULD PARTNER WITH US

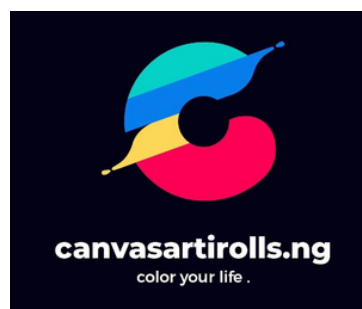
